CONSTITUTION OF THE HOME DEMONSTRATION AGENTS? ASSIN.

ARTICLE I Name.

The name of this organization shall be the Kentucky Home Demonstration Agents! Association.

ARTICLE II Object.

The objects of this organization are to promote the interests of its members to gain a better understanding of each other thru social and friendly contacts and to develop a sympathetic attitude toward problems relating to our work.

ARTICLE III Membership
